




CORE ZONE OF THE HISTORIC CENTRE OF FLORENCE













# Results achieved - FLORENCE HERITAGE DATA SYSTEM




- Creation of a functional and integrated geographic information system

- Updating of the list of buildings that are "at risk" due to disuse and/or decay, of the mapping of attributes of Outstanding Universal Value and potential future ones,












# **Results achieved – UPDATING OF URBAN PLANS**



#### **Art. 15 Regional Landscape Plan (PIT)**

- identification of WHS areas
- quality objectives aligned with the site values
- •common regulations for all the WH sites in Tuscany

#### **Urban Master Plan**

(In Italy, the Urban Master Plans consist of two distinct urban planning tools: *Piano Strutturale* and *Piano Operativo*)

- Table 3 of the Piano Strutturale identifies UNESCO designations subject to protection
- ■Art. 59-69 of the *Piano Operativo*:
- stipulates that the Historic Centre (Core zone) and the Villas (Core & Buffer zones) are exluded from areas where solar panels can be installed:
- any interventions altering the city skyline must undergo prior verification using the visual cone method.

#### **Heritage Impact Assessment**

In 2018 HeRe\_Lab developed a Preliminary Investigation Model based on the mechanisms of the **Heritage Impact Assessment** that serves to monitor and direct urban development projects.


